

**Town of Gardner**  
**ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH SPEED ZONE**  
**ORDINANCE NO. 3-2003**

**WHEREAS** Wisconsin State Statutes Section 346.57(3)(g) states the town may lower a speed limit to 25 mph.

**AND WHEREAS** the Town of Gardner wishes to establish a 25 mph speed limit for a portion of Rileys Point Road from the intersection of Wood Lane and Rileys Point Road north to the road end.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is hereby resolved that the Town Board of the Town of Gardner does hereby ordain as follows:

The maximum permissible speed at which vehicles may be operated on said town road, which speed is herewith established as reasonable and safe pursuant to Section 349.11 of Wisconsin State Statutes, shall be as set forth herein, subject to approval by the State Highway Commission, and upon the erection of standard signs giving notices thereof:

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, any person violating any provision of this ordinance may be fined not less than \$20 nor more the \$200.00.
